

Worked All New Brunswick Counties Award

Presented by the Atlantic Canada DX & Contest Group

The Worked All New Brunswick Counties Award was created to recognize and celebrate the achievement of amateur radio operators who successfully establish two-way contacts across the province of New Brunswick, Canada.

New Brunswick comprises 15 counties, each with its unique history, culture, and geography. Working stations across these counties represent a technical and operating challenge and a way to connect with the people and communities that make up this diverse province.

This award program is designed to encourage activity on the amateur bands, promote interest in New Brunswick amateur radio, and highlight the vital role of counties as a geographic and operating reference.

Eligibility

- The award is open to all licensed amateur radio operators worldwide.
- All amateur bands and modes are valid, provided the operator is licensed to use them.
- Contacts must be two-way (cross-band or one-way contacts do not qualify).

Award Levels

Certificates will be issued in recognition of the following levels of achievement:

- Bronze Certificate Confirmed contacts in 3 counties
- Silver Certificate Confirmed contacts in 5 counties
- Gold Certificate Confirmed contacts in 10 counties
- Platinum Certificate Confirmed contacts in all 15 counties (Worked All New Brunswick Counties)



Rules & Requirements

- 1. All contacts must be made on any amateur radio band.
- 2. Contacts may be made at any time there are no date restrictions.
- 3. The activating station will upload logs, and that station must upload its logs to HamLog.
- 4. Each county counts only once toward the award, regardless of band or mode.
- 5. Portable and mobile operations within New Brunswick counties are valid and encouraged.

Application Process

- Applicants will receive verification on HamLog when they qualify for an award.
- All awards will be in PDF format and downloaded from HamLog.

Purpose & Spirit of the Award

The Worked All New Brunswick Counties Award is more than just a certificate — it is a celebration of the spirit of amateur radio. By working stations across New Brunswick, operators demonstrate skill in propagation, patience in operating, and dedication to building community connections.

Whether you achieve the Bronze level or the ultimate Platinum award for working all 15 counties, your accomplishment reflects both personal achievement and contribution to the vitality of amateur radio in Atlantic Canada.
